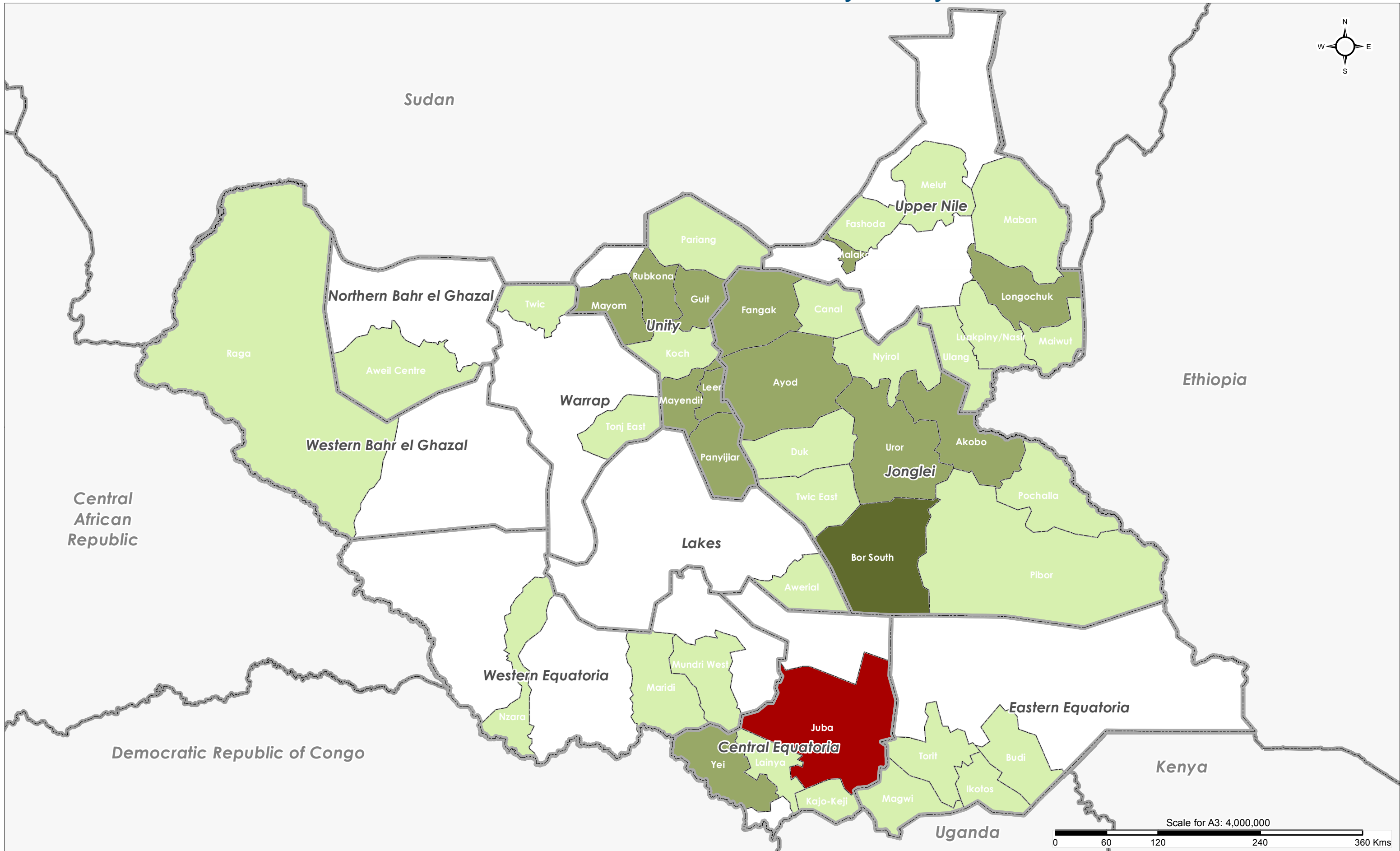
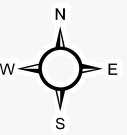


South Sudan - UN House IDP Site PoC1 Ext1 & Ext2 - Previous residence of the IDPs by county

This map shows the place of residence of the IDPs before the crisis started. Most of the IDPs in UN House (75%) were already residents in Juba county in December even though this county is the area of origin of only 7% of them and there are other main areas of origin (Leer 11%, Akobo 15%). This breakdown, which separated Juba from the other counties, allows to have a better overview at country level of the previous residence distribution.
