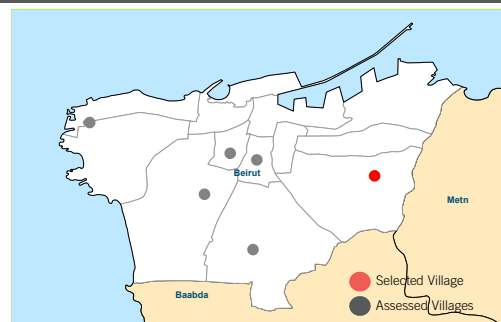

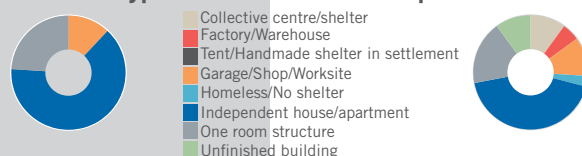

Kind of occupancy arrangement

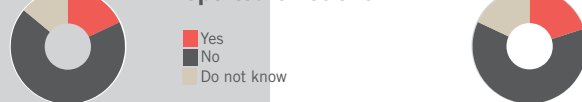

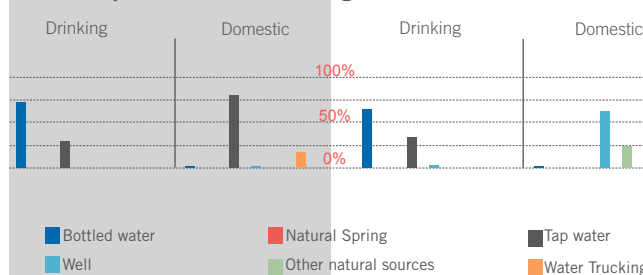

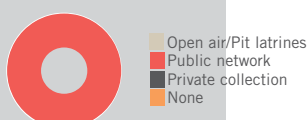
