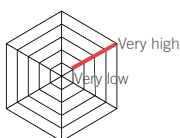

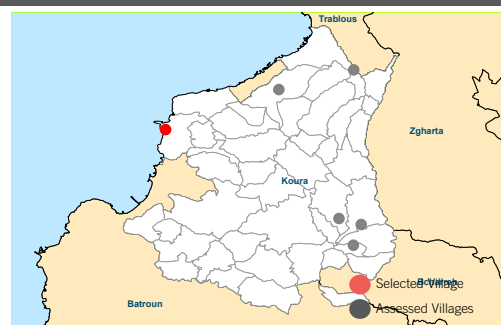

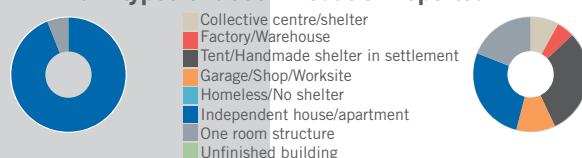

Kind of occupancy arrangement

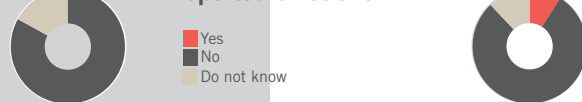

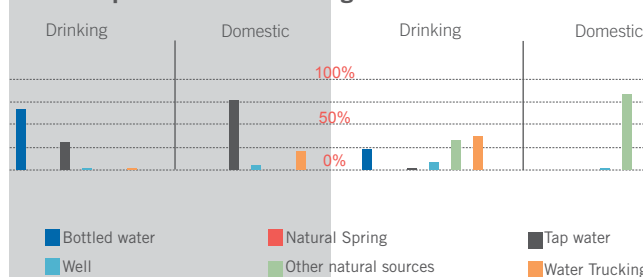

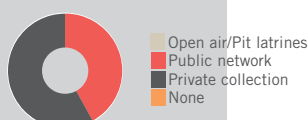
