


Surface Area of Settlement Per Person (August 2014)



The population per settlement was estimated by multiplying the average number of persons per household by the number of shelters counted by UNOSAT satellite image analysis. The analysis of satellite imagery represents the estimated population as of 14 June 2014. The average number of people per shelter was calculated for the Luuq area with a 95% confidence level using data collected during a REACH assessment at the beginning of September 2014. The average household size calculated by this assessment was 8.5. Each household had an average of 2 shelters.
