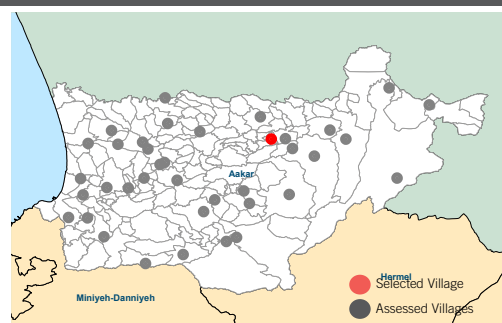

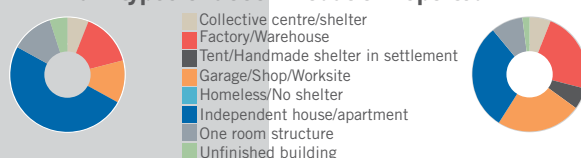

## Kind of occupancy arrangement

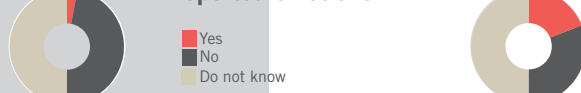

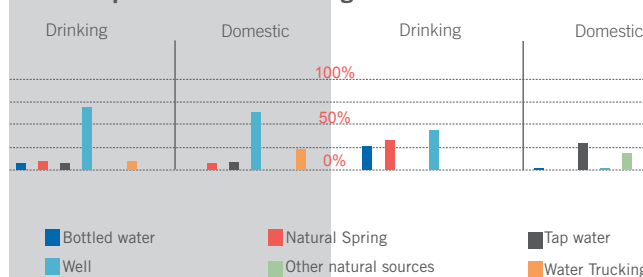

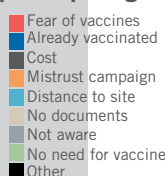
