

# Mingkaman Snapshot

Awerial County, Lakes State, South Sudan

#### Summary

Following the outbreak of violence in December 2013, internally displaced persons (IDPs) started arriving in Mingkaman Site.


During the past months refugee returnees arrived in small numbers and new IDPs, mainly due to the pull-factor of service provision. However, without IOM registration they are excluded from the Food Distribution - which is causing some tension with the local authorities.

Data was provided by IOM DTM and camp manager (as of 04/11/2015), spatial data was provided by REACH (as of 28/04/2015).




### Mingkaman Site Map
