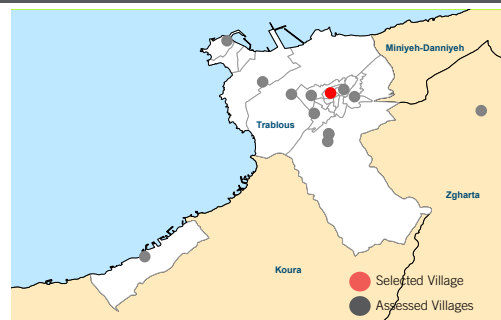

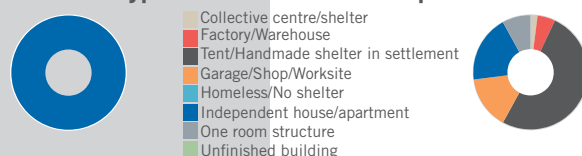

Kind of occupancy arrangement

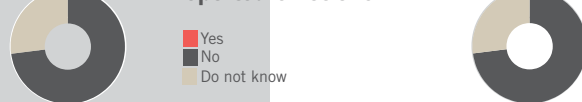

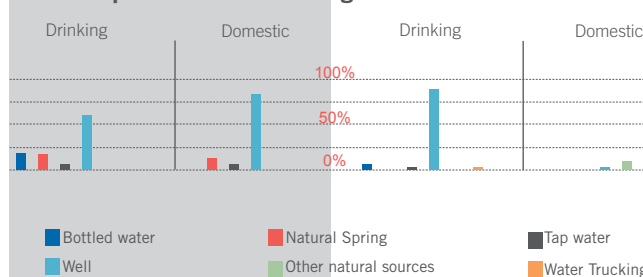
