

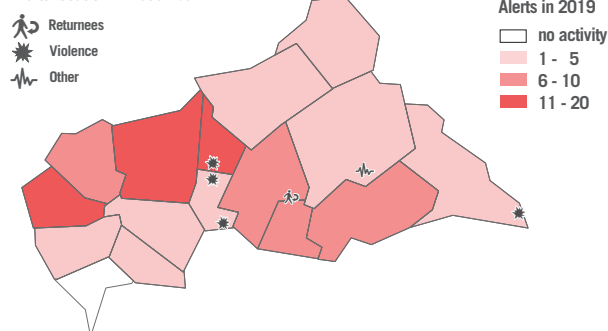


The Rapid Response Mechanism (RRM) is designed to monitor humanitarian action, conduct multisector assessments and to implement several emergency responses, including non-food items (NFI) and HEB<sup>1</sup> distributions, water, sanitation and hygiene (WASH) interventions, cash activities and fairs. Currently, RRM is made possible through the generous support of the European Union Civil Protection and Humanitarian Aid Office (ECHO), the Office of U.S. Foreign Disaster Assistance (OFDA), the Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency (SIDA) and the Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation (SDC). 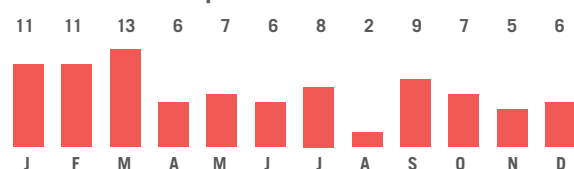

### Alert distribution in December 2019 and in 2019 :

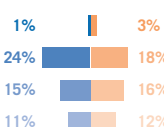
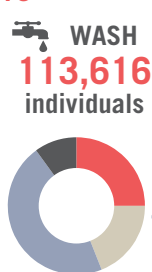
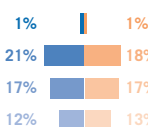
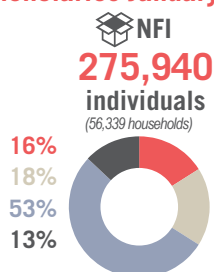
Alerts location in December :



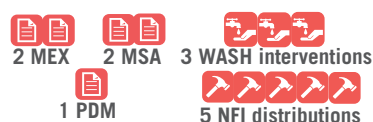
### Nombre d'alertes par mois en 2019 :



## Beneficiaries January - December 2019

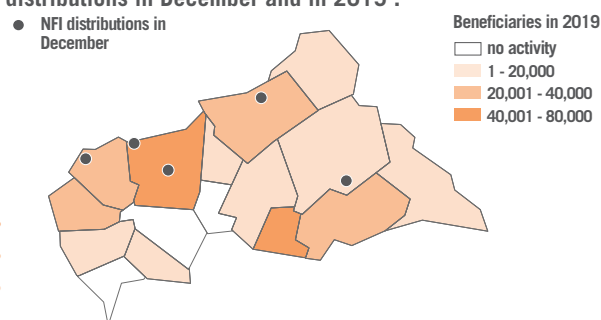


### RRM activities in December 2019:

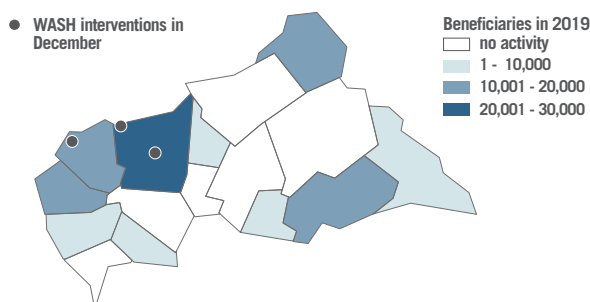


### Distribution of beneficiaries

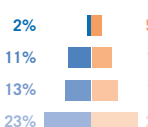
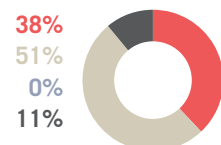
#### NFI distributions in December and in 2019 :



#### WASH interventions in December and in 2019:



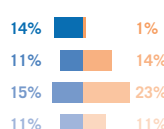
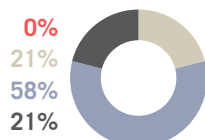
