

IRAQ - Camps Intentions Survey Round 2 **Governorate of Origin: Ninewa**


This Intentions Survey was carried out by REACH in support of the CCCM Cluster in 61 camps across 11 governorates. The survey was administered to 5,731 households through a random sample¹ between 12 December 2017 and 14 January 2018. 3,176 households reported being from Ninewa.

Conditions in area of origin (AoO)




What is the primary barrier to return related to the condition of your house in your AoO?






Planning to return to area of origin





CCCM CLUSTER

A random GPS sampling technique was applied in each camp. When aggregated to the governorate of origin level, findings were statistically representative with a 95% confidence and 1.7% margin of error. However, questions asked only to a subset of the sample (i.e. those who intend to return) are presented with a margin of error between 2% and 4%
