Methodological Note for the 2024 Calculation of WASH PiN and Severity

October 2023



This methodological note explains how the number of People in Need (PiN) of Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) assistance and the WASH Severity Scores for each district in Yemen will be calculated for the **2024 Yemen Humanitarian Needs Overview (HNO)**.

1. BACKGROUND

The conflict in Yemen entered its ninth year in 2023. A first UN-brokered truce was agreed upon between the warring parties in April 2022 and lasted until October of the same year. The truce resulted in decreased levels of fighting across the country, while needs remained high nationwide. The main drivers of needs are protracted conflict, climatic hazards, and lack of economic opportunities. The conflict has aggravated the country's underlying food insecurity, while also compromising essential services and infrastructure, including related to health and education, and significantly damaging the economy and the social fabric. While the UN-brokered truce from 2022 has indicated improved conditions, the population remains vulnerable and in need. Yemen remains one of the largest internal displacement crises globally, with an internally displaced persons (IDP) population of over 4.5 million.¹ Water and sanitation systems and services throughout the country have suffered from damage and underdevelopment. In the 2023 Humanitarian Needs Overview (HNO), the Yemen WASH Cluster (YWC) reported that 15.3 million people are in need.² Needs are identified to be more acute closer to conflict frontlines, as both IDPs and non-IDPs face acute WASH needs in these areas.³ Needs are high in both urban and rural areas and while durable WASH support reached 3 million people in 2022 there are significant gaps in humanitarian funding to improve WASH response activities and provide relief for environmental impacts for Yemenis nationwide.⁴ Despite pressing needs, WASH funding for Yemen has only reached 30% of the required funding for 2023.⁵ Identifying and prioritizing communities most in need, and determining their vulnerabilities and risks, is therefore highly necessary.

2. RATIONALE

In order to understand the WASH needs, risks and vulnerabilities of the population in Yemen, the 2024 HNO assesses WASH-related indicators across all districts in Yemen. The YWC has partnered with REACH to produce an analysis of these indicators to determine the number of People in Need (PiN), and the severity of needs, by demographic group and geographic location. This document outlines the selected indicators and resources which will be used for informing the HNO, how these indicators are built, how the severity of needs is scaled, and how the number of PiN is calculated.

3. ANALYTICAL FRAMEWORK

The analytical framework utilized for WASH-related indicators within the scope of the 2024 HNO is grounded in the recently updated Joint Inter-Sectoral Analysis Framework (JIAF) 2.0. Additionally, this analytical framework draws upon the sector-specific Global WASH Cluster 2022 HNO PiN & Severity Score Calculation Guidance. This sector-specific guidance is designed to align with JIAF recommendations while also remaining adaptable to accommodate variations in data availability and specific requirements.

JIAF 2.0 serves as a structure for humanitarian actors to organize, analyze, and synthesize information for assessing the humanitarian and protection needs of affected populations. Notably, the Global WASH Cluster guidance has not undergone any changes from the previous year; as such, the HNO PiN & Severity Score Calculation for 2024 will be based on the Global WASH Cluster 2022 guidance.

The calculation of PiN and Severity Scores for the WASH HNO will primarily rely on indicators derived from two primary data sources: the WASH Needs Tracking System (WANTS) for non-IDPs and both

WANTS and the CCCM Site Monitoring Tool (SMT) for IDPs. A brief description of the main data sources and their methodologies included in the **8. Annexes** offers a comprehensive understanding of the data, including its coverage and the underlying sampling framework.

The table below will indicate the chosen indicators and sources, as per the Global WASH Cluster guidance, for calculating the HNO 2024 PiN & Severity Score

4. ANALYSIS PROCESS

Due to data scarcity and the absence of nation-wide household (HH) assessments, the 2024 WASH Severity Score and PiN calculations will be based on WANTS and CCCM Site Monitoring Tool (SMT) data collected in 2023.

Based on OCHA’s recommendations for the 2024 HPC and with the aim of capturing the difference in needs between Internally Displaced Population (IDPs) and non-IDPs, PiN and severity scores will be calculated separately for both population groups. The resources will be used as follows:

WASH HNO PiN & Severity Score Calculation will be based on indicators that will be first and foremost informed by primary data collected through WANTS for non IDPS and through WANTS and SMT for IDPs.

As outlined in Table 2 below, whenever information is not available from WANTS assessment for a particular district, HNO 2023 figures will be considered as a second option for non-IDP population, and whenever information is not available from WANTS and SMT assessments for a particular district, HNO 2023 figures will be considered as a second option for IDP population.

5. SEVERITY SCORES CALCULATION FOR WASH INDICATORS

This section outlines the different indicators chosen for the 2023 HNO calculations and the distribution of severities on a 1-5 scale depending on answer choices.

5.1 Indicators and Severity Score Classifications

5.1.1 Access to improved water source.

The measurement of the main water source for the population will indicate whether SPHERE standards are achieved. Improved drinking water sources are those that have the potential to deliver safe water by the nature of their design and construction. The table below outlines the water source used in the framework of this exercise:

5.1.2. Access to water sources of sufficient quantity of water

Access to sufficient water quantity will be measured by having enough water for all purposes (drinking and other non-drinking purposes); this measurement will indicate whether SPHERE standards are achieved.

5.1.3. Access to functional handwashing facility (and soap)

The measurement of access to functional handwashing facility (and soap) will indicate whether SPHERE standards are achieved. A functioning hand-washing facility comprises water, soap, and a pouring device.

5.1.4. Access to improved sanitation facility

The measurement of access to functional sanitation facility will indicate whether SPHERE standards are achieved. Sanitation services refer to the management of excreta. This indicator is measured according to the following:

6. AGGREGATED SEVERITY SCORES AND PEOPLE IN NEED

6.1. Aggregated Severity Scores

The steps below will be followed to calculate the Severity Scores for both population groups:

- Based on the percentages per answer choices for the selected indicators, a five-point severity score will be assigned for each indicator at district level, as described in Section 5 above.
- The 25% rule will be used to determine the severity score per indicator per district. The percentages for each severity score are added up gradually starting with severity 5 until 25% is reached; the severity score in which the percentage reaches 25% or more will be determined as the final severity score for the district for each indicator.
- An overall severity score will be calculated per district using an average of all eight indicators for Non-IDPs and all seven indicators for IDPs.
- The overall severity score for all population at the district level will be the highest score between IDPs and Non-IDPs population.
- When assessing the severity score for districts with IDPs population, we will rely on WANTS and SMT data. If neither WANTS nor SMT data is available for a district, we will refer to the severity scores from the previous year. Please refer to [last year's methodology](#) for guidance.
- For districts with non-IDPs population, we will rely on WANTS. For districts in which WANTS data is not available, we will also refer to the last year's severity scores. Please refer to [last year's methodology](#) for guidance.

6.2. Calculate Population in Need (PiN)

The steps below will be followed to calculate PiN for both population groups:

- The percentage of Overall PiN for each indicator is calculated by summing the percentage of people with severity scores 3, 4 & 5. The percentage of Acute PiN for each indicator is calculated by summing the percentage of people with severity scores 4 & 5
- To calculate the overall PiN per district, the average percentage among the five indicators is considered as overall PiN percentage for each population group.
- The number of PiN for each population group will be calculated per district based on the percentage that was calculated and using the 2024 UN Population Projection dataset.
- The **final PiN** number per district for the total population is calculated by adding the total PiN number of IDPs and non-IDPs.
- The **final PiN** number for Yemen is calculated by adding the final PiN number for all districts.
- For those districts in which no data was available for IDP or non-IDP population from the assessments considered for this exercise, the intersectoral PiN was used as a proxy PiN, and the same number of population was assigned for these districts.

7. LIMITATIONS, CHALLENGES, AND LESSONS LEARNED

Due to the lack of nationwide and localized assessments conducted in 2023, the decision has been made to only rely on WANTS and CCCM SMT data for this year's severity score and PiN calculations of the 2024 HNO process. Thus, it is important to outline what the lack of consistent and coherent data means for this process, the limitations and the challenges faced during the development of the methodology note and lessons learned:

1. WANTS and CCCM SMT data are the only data sources for WASH in Yemen with up-to-date data and clear methodology stating data collection, data cleaning, and analysis. There are data sources available through the OCHA assessment registry, however, these sources do not cover all WASH HNO indicators and lack a clear methodology.
2. There are variations to the questions/indicators used between the WANTS and SMT data sources. The differences relate to the format of the question/indicator and the number of answer options that could be provided for the questions by the KI. In WANTS, KIs could only provide one answer while KIs responding to the SMT survey could provide multiple answers on the same question. Furthermore, the SMT data does not include any indicators indicating hygiene needs, such as access to handwashing facilities or to soap. These differences were taken into consideration when developing the methodology through consultation with Yemen WASH Cluster and the Global WASH Cluster who provided the best classification of the responses into the 5-severity scale.
3. There is a lack of updated, nationwide, household level data in Yemen. Data collection partners have faced difficulties in collecting data throughout the country but most specifically in the north. Partners have faced challenges in collecting data in areas under the control of the Sana'a Based Authorities.
4. There are data gaps within the data used for this year's HNO calculations as the WANTS and SMT data do not cover all of Yemen's 333 districts. In total, WASH cluster partners have collected data in 146 districts through the sampling framed provided by REACH. In around 50 of these districts, less data have been collected than what was provided through the sampling frame. Thus, for the districts not covered through either of these data sources, last year's calculations will provide the basis of the severity score and PiN, as agreed with the YWC and Global WASH cluster.
5. In addition, it is worth noting the lack of committed partners for data collection in Yemen. YWC partners who have engaged in data collection using WANTS tools do not have enough

resources to allocate budgets for data collection activities. This includes expenses related to enumerators, transportation fees, renting venues for training, and providing staff with necessary assets such as mobile phones, tablets, or laptops. This challenge is particularly raised when dealing with national non-governmental organizations (NNGOs) that have limited or no budgetary resources allocated for these purposes.

6. The constrained timeframe placed considerable limitations on the ability to conduct thorough consultations with partners and stakeholders regarding the selection of indicators and the methodology to be employed. Despite our strong commitment to fostering collaboration and inclusivity, the time constraints imposed by this particular endeavor ultimately hindered the depth of engagement we would have preferred with our partners and stakeholders.

8. ANNEXES

Annex 1: Data sources

1. The WASH Needs Tracking System (WANTS)

The WASH Needs Tracking System (WANTS) is a toolkit provided by REACH, where data is collected through the Yemen WASH Cluster partners on a rolling basis. The data collected with key informants (KIs) through WANTS between June and August 2023 was compiled and disaggregated by represented population group (KIs representing IDP communities and KIs representing non-IDP population). For the WASH HNO 2023, WANTS data was prioritized to inform the severity score and PiN calculations, as it was the most updated source of data for the districts covered. The displacement status of the population represented by KIs was recorded through the questionnaires, and the data was disaggregated by population group during the analysis process.

The main limitation of using WANTS data was the lack of nationwide coverage. Only 178 districts were assessed by WANTS between June and August 2023. Although WANTS data was considered to inform the IDP severity score and PiN calculation, the CCCM Site Monitoring tool was also used to address the gaps in IDP coverage resulting from the limited data provided by WANTS.

Data collection methodology

In order to cover as many districts as possible, taking into consideration the limited resources available to YWC partners, data was collected through KIs. Partners collected data through the WANTS KI tool using KoBo. Data was collected at the community level through interviews with community leaders or WASH experts in the area, such as members of Water Committees or WASH area managers at NGOs. KIs were asked to respond WANTS survey on behalf of all population groups including men and women, host communities, IDPs, migrants, refugees, and mixed communities. This methodology allowed for the capture of indicative information about the WASH situation at the district level through a reduced number of interviews.

Sampling Framework

Between 3 and 9 KI interviews were conducted in each district, to account for possible higher variation in needs in districts with a larger population size. The exact number of target KIs in each district was indicated in a sampling frame developed by REACH, in which all 333 districts in Yemen were divided into four categories according to population size: the first category included districts with a population size of less than 50,000; the second category included districts with a population size between 50,000 and 100,000; the third category included districts with a population size between 100,000 and 150,000; and in the fourth category, districts with a population size of more than 150,000 were included. For districts in the first category, partners conducted 3 KI interviews, for the second category, the target sample was 5 KI interviews, for the third category, it was 7 KIs, and for the fourth category, it was 9 KIs. The selection of KIs was done by data collection partners through purposive sampling, meaning that KIs were selected for their knowledge of the WASH situation in their communities. YWC partners

selected the KIs to be interviewed based on their knowledge of the districts in which they operated. During the training, REACH provided partners with guidance on how to select KIs.

WANTS tool covered the following WASH indicators selected to inform the HNO:

- Percentage of KIs by type of main water source used for drinking.
- Percentage of KIs reporting on average time taken by most people in the community to fetch water and return
- Percentage of KIs reporting proportion of the population in the community with access to enough water for drinking
- Percentage of KIs reporting proportion of the population in the community with access to enough water for other non-drinking purposes
- Percentage of KIs reporting people in the community have access to functional handwashing facilities with water and soap available
- Percentage of KIs reporting on proportion of shared sanitation facilities that are gender separated
- Percentage of KIs reporting on proportion of shared sanitation facilities that have functional locks on the inside
- Percentage of KIs by type of main sanitation facility used by most people (improved, non-improved)

2. CCCM Site Monitoring Tool (SMT)

The CCCM Site Monitoring tool is a toolkit provided by REACH. Data is collected through the CCCM Cluster partners from Key Informant Interviews (KIIs) with knowledge of the IDP community. Information about the general conditions of the IDP sites is collected on a rolling basis and analyzed monthly to provide updated datasets of all sites covered through this assessment.

For the WASH HNO 2023, CCCM Site Monitoring data was utilized along with WANTS KI data to inform the IDP severity score and PiN calculations, as these were the most updated sources of data for IDPs. CCCM Site Monitoring covered 253 managed IDP sites (excluding sites under 20 HHs) in 35 districts in IRG-controlled areas. The latest national site master list indicated that there were a total of 268 managed sites in IRG-controlled areas with 20 HHs or more. Hence, coverage from SMT R6 accounted for 253 of the relevant 269 sites.

The tool covers the following WASH indicators selected to inform the HNO:

- Percentage of KIs by type of main water source used for all purposes.
- Percentage of KIs reporting on average time taken by most people in the community to fetch water and return
- Percentage of KIs reporting proportion of the population in the community with access to sufficient amount of water for drinking and other non-drinking purposes
- Percentage of KIs reporting on proportion of shared sanitation facilities that are gender separated
- Percentage of KIs reporting on proportion of shared sanitation facilities that have functional locks on the inside
- Percentage of KIs by type of main sanitation facility used by most people (improved, non-improved)

3. Data sources for uncovered districts

As there were no comprehensive nationwide or localized assessments conducted in 2023, it has been determined that only WANTS and CCCM SMT data will be used to establish this year’s WASH severity score and PiN calculations for the 2024 HNO process. Additionally, for districts not covered with these two assessments, YWC and REACH have decided to use the severity scores from last year. Please refer to [last year’s methodology](#) for guidance.
