

Summary

This profile provides an overview of water, sanitation and hygiene (WASH) infrastructure within Hakimpara in Ukhiya, Cox's Bazar. Primary data for this round was collected between 20 October and 9 November 2017.1 Findings should be considered indicative only.

¹ REACH enumerators conducted a full sweep of all sites and camps (as per boundaries defined by ISCG) and used an Open Data Kit (ODK) form to log all key infrastructure observed during this sweep, with further details to be logged for WASH infrastructure. ⁴ Safe refers to fully covered latrines (i.e. a latrine with four walls, a roof and a door) ³ This farget is based on standards for the medium and long term (3 months +), for the immediate phase (0-3 months) it is 1000. ⁴ The distance is based on standards for the long term (6 months+), for the immediate phase (0-3 months) it is 750 metres and for the medium phase (3-6 months) 500 metres.


