

Displacement Intentions of IDPs in Informal Sites

Centre/ South Iraq

March 2017

Summary

Understanding the displacement intentions of IDPs can provide some indication of potential return movements, areas of return, as well as a sign of the voluntariness of return. REACH initiative and IOM captured intentions data in informal IDP sites on behalf of the CCCM cluster through the Risk Assessment Site Priority (RASP) Assessment in Centre and Southern governorates. This assessment involves a full census of all informal IDP settlements within Centre-South Iraq. Primary data was collected through Key informant interviews between 8 February 2017 - 25 March 2017 *.Overall, 1,018 sites were assessed as active sites (hosting five or more IDP families). All data presented is at the site level and does not account for the individual opinions of households.
