This map shows the place of origin of IDP at the UN House site. The black circles show the place of origin of IDP across South Sudan: 69.6% are from Central Equatoria and 14.3% from Unity State. The arrows represent the proportion of IDP from neighbourhoods in Juba. For example, 14% IDP Households in UN House Site came from Jebel Market neighbourhood.

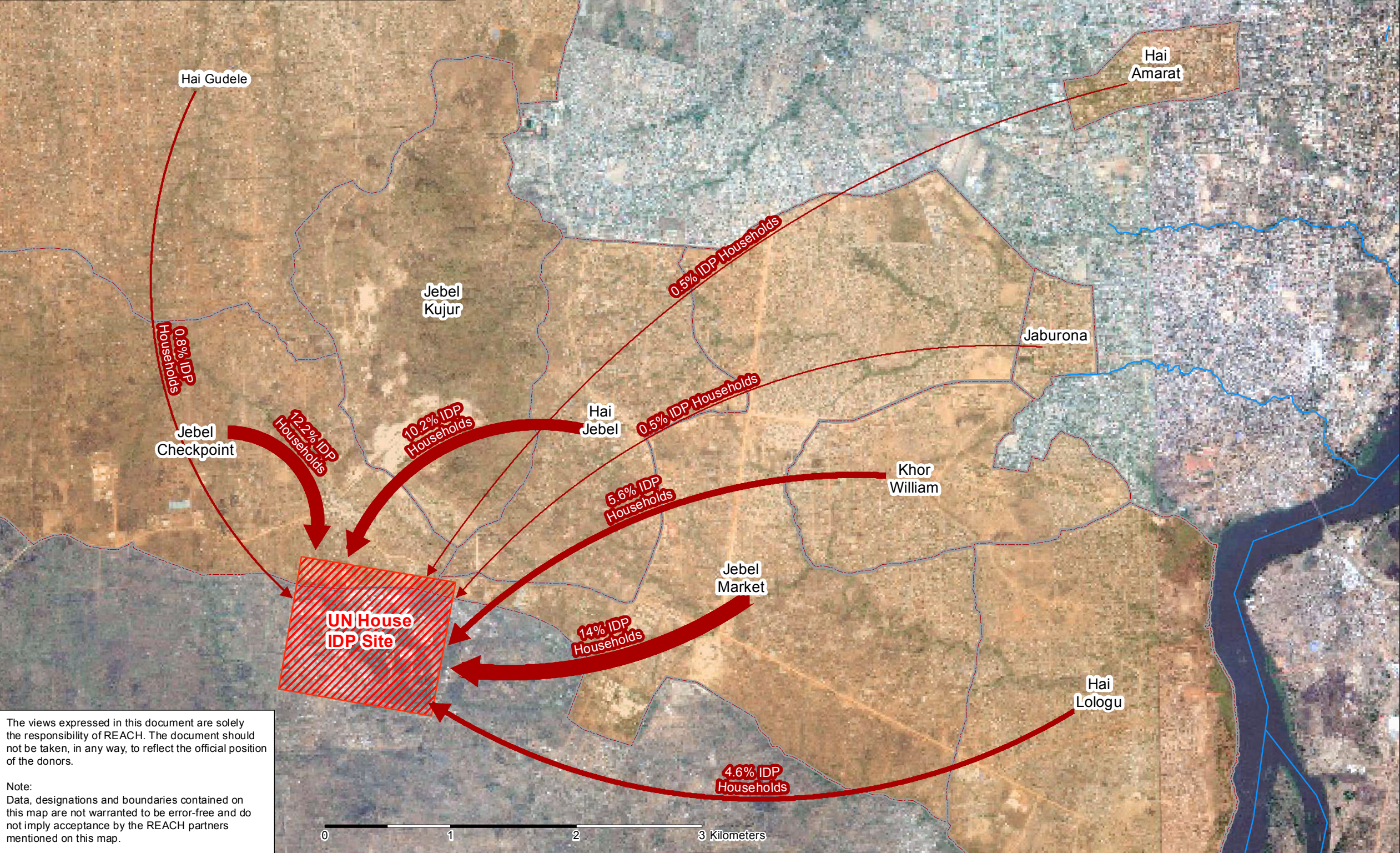
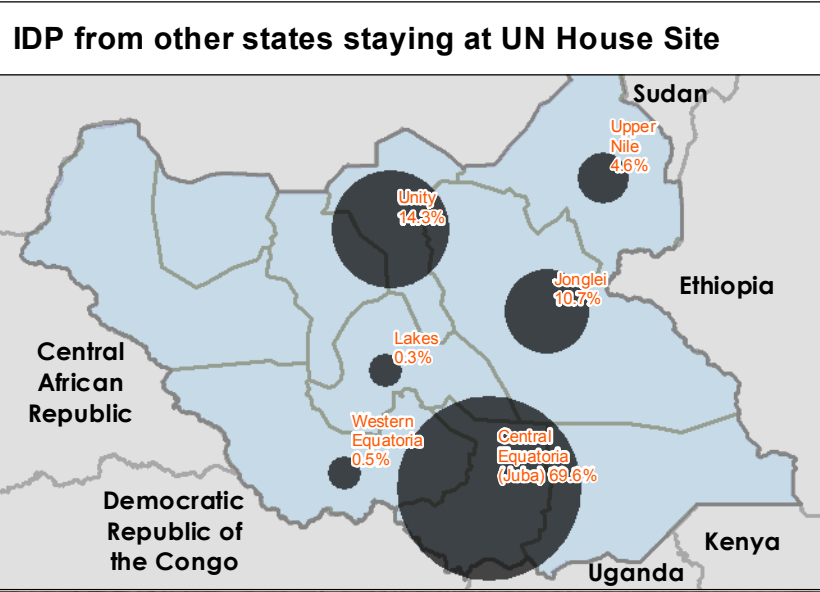
The data used here comes from a shelter assessment conducted in UN House. Based on a random sample methodology and on an estimated population of 7,341, a sample of 392 household interviews were collected to ensure a 95% level of confidence and a 5% margin of error.
