

Doro Refugee Camp - Key Sector Findings

Maban County, Upper Nile State, South Sudan

This factsheet provides an overview of key findings from a comprehensive assessment of the camp.

Findings are based on data collected from 7,720 households, between 20 August and 20 November 2015, and can be generalised to the entire camp population with 99% confidence and 0.9% margin of error.

Total camp population: **51,659** (UNHCR)

Children aged under 18: **81%**

Average household size: **4.6**

Age dependency ratio: **270**

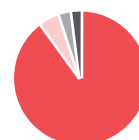

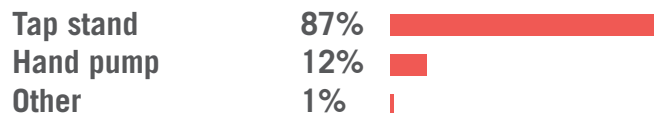

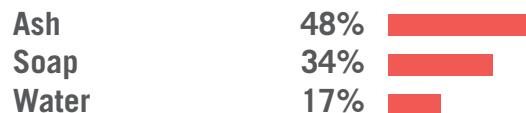
Water, Hygiene & Sanitation

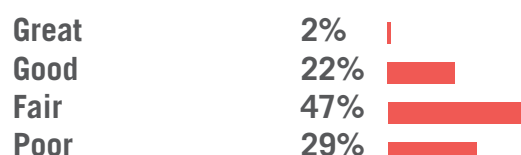
