



Damage to Buildings and Key Infrastructure

Composite score of KI damage estimates for buildings and key types of infrastructure

The Damage Score combines information on the level of damage of key infrastructure. Specifically, residential buildings, markets, health facilities, water networks/wells, roads, electricity networks, telecommunications/internet infrastructure, and education facilities are included. Residential buildings, markets, health facilities, water networks/wells, and roads are weighted twice as highly. A score of 0 indicates that no infrastructure was damaged while a score of 1 indicates that all infrastructure was completely destroyed.
