Bentiu Snapshot

Summary

Bentiu protection of civilians site (PoC) was established in December 2013 following the outbreak of violence.

In the past months Bentiu Poc has experienced a large-scale relocation of IDPs from it's former site to a larger new extension, and a considerable influx of new arrivals due to renewed fighting in the area.

Location Map





Bentiu Site Map




