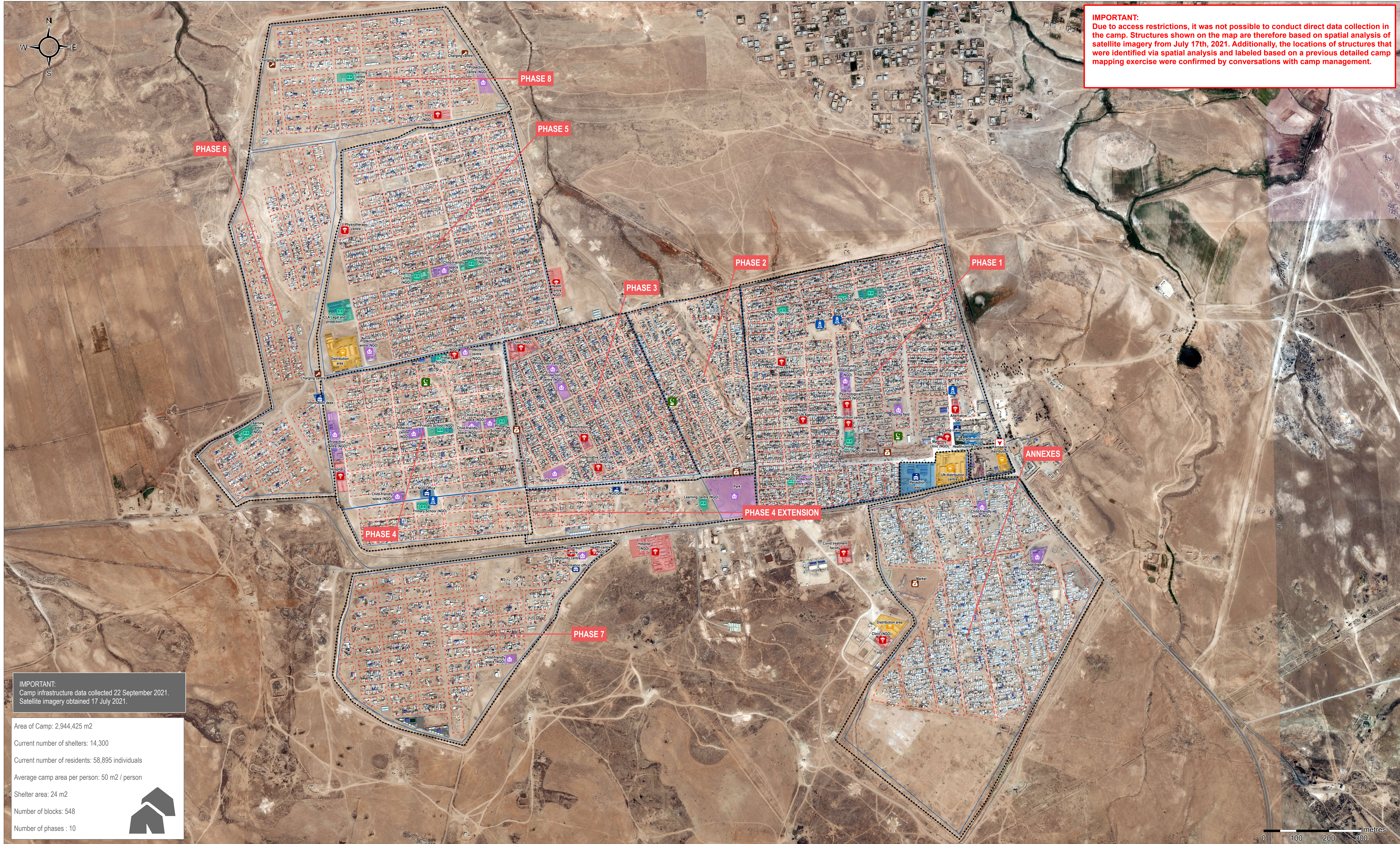


SYRIA - Al Hol Refugee / IDP Camp

IMPORTANT:
Due to access restrictions, it was not possible to conduct direct data collection in the camp. Structures shown on the map are therefore based on spatial analysis of satellite imagery from July 17th, 2021. Additionally, the locations of structures that were identified via spatial analysis and labeled based on a previous detailed camp mapping exercise were confirmed by conversations with camp management.
