- Front line prior to 24 February 2022
- Territory of armed conflict as of December 2022
- Areas beyond the control of the Government of Ukraine prior to February 24th, 2022
- Out of 9 monitored collective centers 8 informed no assistance received in the last 2 weeks before data collection

Proportion of sites that reported receiving humanitarian assistance in the last 14 days prior to the data collection
