

## Introduction

In support of the CCCM Cluster, REACH Initiative and IOM initiated the sixth round of the Informal IDP Site Assessment to **identify and assess all IDP informal sites (hosting five families or more) across Iraq**.<sup>1</sup> Data collection was completed between 3 February and 23 April 2017.


## Red-Flag findings

This round of the site assessment integrated a red-flagging mechanism, based on 20 agreed upon indicators. More information on district-level red-flags is available on pages 2 to 4.


### Top 5 reported red-flag concerns:

| Evidence of overcrowding  | 60% |  |
| Female head of household present in the site                      | 54% |  |
| Less than 25% of households have access to reliable income        | 52% |  |
| Majority of residents planning to leave site in next three months | 46% |  |
| Insufficient and unreliable access to food                        | 41% |  |




## Informal IDP Site Caseload (Individuals)


### Site residents intentions for next 3 months<sup>3</sup>
