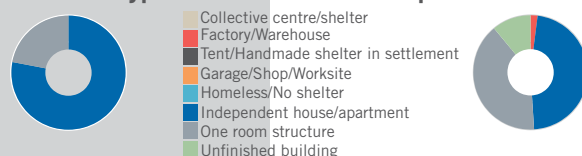

Kind of occupancy arrangement

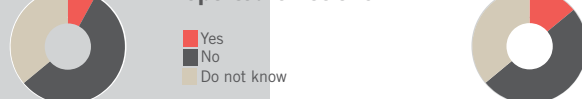

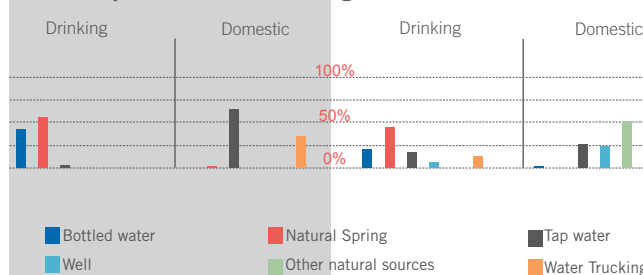

Average monthly expenditure on drinking water per HH

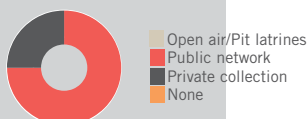
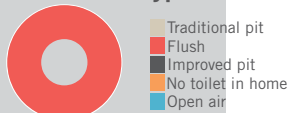
