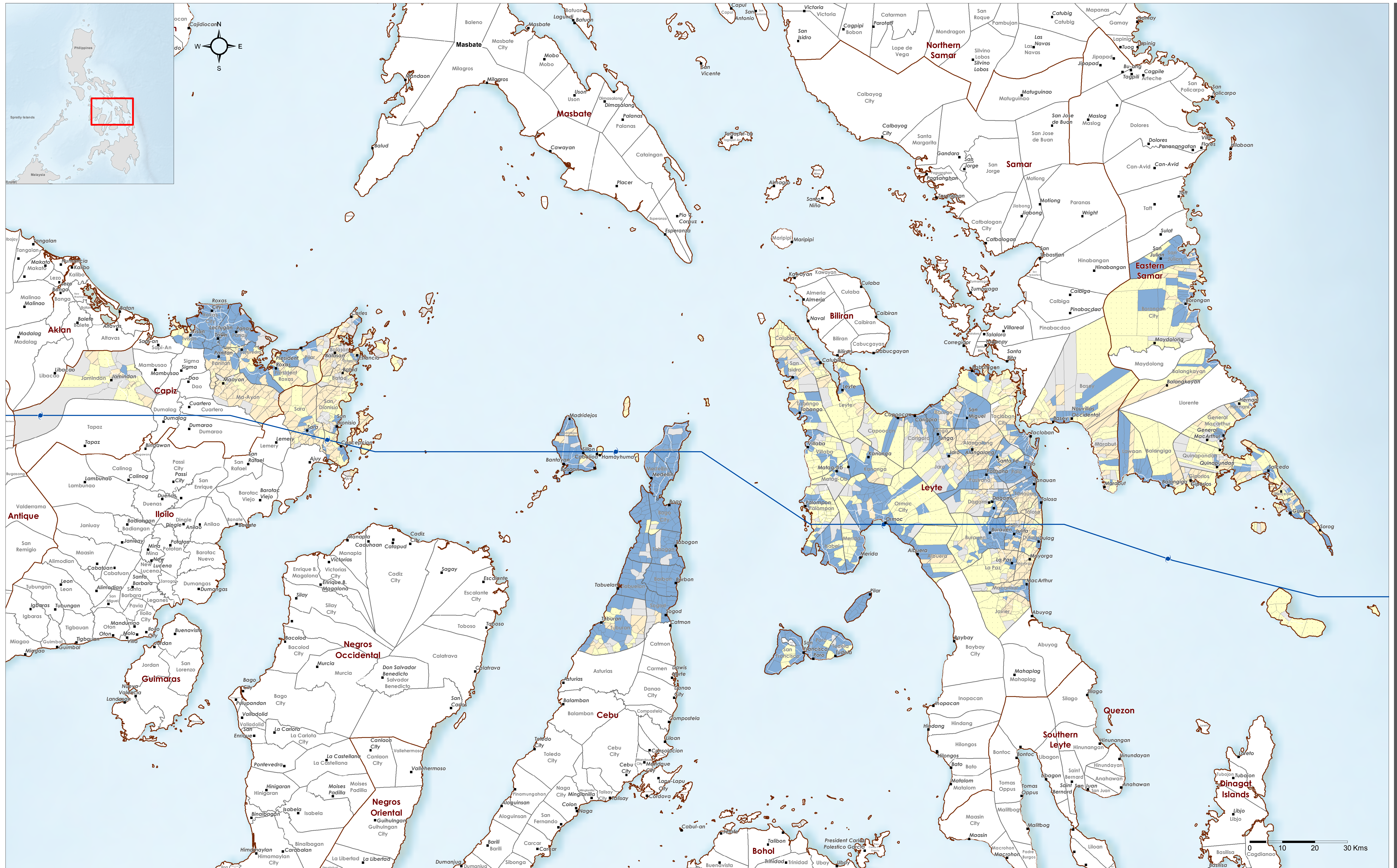




Predominant WASH Infrastructure Type in the Barangay
