* Limitation in comparability: In 2021, in-camp refugees were categorized into a distinct stratum and not included in the aggregation at HNO areas level, whereas, in 2022, in-camp households were directly incorporated into their corresponding geographic stratum (within Area A/B or H2) with out-camp households. Furthermore, the precision of the sampling has been increased between 2021 and 2022 for Area A/B, resulting in a considerably increased sample size (210 households interviewed in 2021 for Area A/B compared to 1855 in 2022).
