



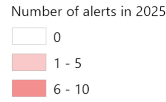
The Rapid Response Mechanism (RRM) is designed to monitor humanitarian situation in a context of sudden onset emergencies, conduct multisector assessments (MSAs) of needs and to provide various types of emergency assistance in order to save lives, including distribution of essential non-food items (NFIs), emergency water, sanitation and hygiene (WASH) interventions, as well as cash transfer programming (CTP). Currently, the RRM is made possible through the support of the Directorate-General for European Civil Protection and Humanitarian Aid Operations (DG ECHO), the Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation (SDC) and the Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency (SIDA). 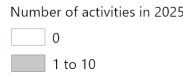

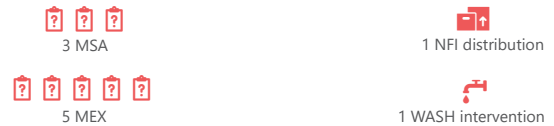

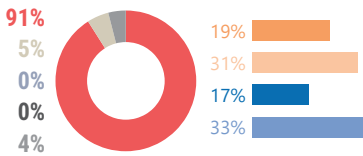

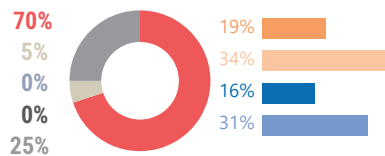

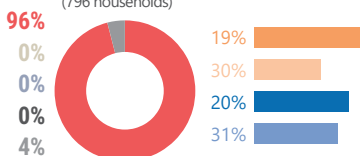

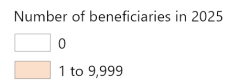

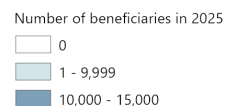
#### NFI distributions in March 2025 :
