


Iraq: COVID-19 Vulnerable Populations Among IDPs Living Inside of Formal Camps - March 2020



23,600 out of 278,200 Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs) living in formal camps are estimated to be vulnerable to COVID-19*

*Vulnerable populations are identified as people age 65 and above and/or with a pre-existing health condition



Households considered to be internally displaced in camps are those displaced from their sub-district between 2014-2017, but still living in Iraq, living inside of formal camps.





Iraq: COVID-19 Vulnerable Populations Among Returnees - March 2020

 **312,300 out of 4,660,400 returnees are estimated to be vulnerable to COVID-19***

*Vulnerable populations are identified as people age 65 and above and/or with a pre-existing health condition



Households considered to be returnees are those displaced between 2014-2017 who have since returned to their sub-district (though not always their original house, neighborhood or town).
