

Note: Cyclone shelter infrastructure includes mosques, madrasas, primary schools, high schools, college buildings, health facilities and union parishads. This dataset is an inventory of public and community infrastructure in Ukhia and Teknaf upazilas with the minimum robustness, design and capacity to serve as cyclone shelters for the public. Indicative catchment areas are based on the nationally accepted standard for maximum access radius, not population. The dataset includes both designated multi-purpose cyclone shelters constructed under dedicated programmes, and other public and community infrastructure identified by the local government as suitable for the purpose. Buildings were identified in dialogue with upazila and union administrations.

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
