

# South Sudan | Joint Market Monitoring Initiative (JMMI)

1 - 7 March 2025

## Market Overview

### INTRODUCTION

With the aim of informing cash-based interventions and to better understand market dynamics in South Sudan, the **Joint Market Monitoring Initiative (JMMI)** was initiated by the South Sudan Cash Working Group (CWG) in August 2019. The initiative is guided by the JMMI Technical Working Group, led by REACH, and supported by the CWG members. The initiative is funded by the Foreign, Commonwealth & Development Office (FCDO). Marketplaces across South Sudan are assessed on a monthly basis. In each location, field teams record prices and other market indicators through trader interviews. This factsheet presents an overview of prices for key foods and non-food items (NFIs) in the assessed areas, as well as the costs associated with key elements of the **Multi-Sector Survival Minimum Expenditure Basket (MSSMEB)**.

### Market Functionality Score (MFS)

The Market Functionality Score (MFS) is a method of classifying markets based on their level of functionality. The MFS is divided into five dimensions:

- **Accessibility (25%)**: physical and social access to markets
- **Availability (30%)**: ability of markets to consistently supply core commodities
- **Affordability (15%)**: financial access to markets and price volatility
- **Resilience (20%)**: vulnerability of supply chains and ease of restocking
- **Infrastructure (10%)**: state of markets' physical and financial infrastructure



### MARKET FUNCTIONALITY SCORE (MFS), BY LOCATION



### KEY FINDINGS

- Between February and March 2025, the median cost of the MSSMEB increased by 9% while the food basket increased by 11%. The increase in MSSMEB costs is primarily driven by price increase for essential food items and other services such as cooking oil (40%), milling cost (37%), salt (35%), beans (11%), and sorghum grain (8%).
- The highest MSSMEB prices were recorded in **Leer Town**, **Old Fangak**, **Melut Town**, and **Ganyiel** (Panyijiar County).
- Since February 2025, **Old Fangak** has experienced the highest monthly increase, with the **MSSMEB** rising by 50% and the **food basket** soaring by 67%. **Luonyaker** (Gogrial East County) experienced a 25% increase in the **MSSMEB** and a 29% rise in the **food basket**, while **Turalei** (Twic County) saw a 25% increase in the **MSSMEB** and a 34% rise in the **food basket**, and **Maiwut** increased by 23% in the **MSSMEB** and a 9% in the **food basket**.
- Traders in the assessed locations reported that **roads** were all opened normally, with some reporting insecurity along the roads.
- The continuous rise in the cost of living in South Sudan could be attributed to several factors, such as the **depreciation of the South Sudanese Pound (SSP)** (mentioned by 39% of surveyed traders) and various restocking challenges, including **poor road conditions** (47%), **high taxation in the marketplace** (30%), **high checkpoint cost** (29%), **high fuel prices** (26%), **border closures** (24%), **insecurity along supply route** (22%), and **insecurity in the marketplaces** (20%).

## MULTI-SECTORAL SURVIVAL MINIMUM EXPENDITURE BASKET (MSSMEB)

The Multi-Sectoral Survival Minimum Expenditure Basket (MSSMEB) represents the minimum culturally adjusted group of items required to support a six-person South Sudanese household for one month. The cost of the MSSMEB can be used as a proxy for the financial burdens faced by households in different locations. The MSSMEB's contents were defined by the CWG in consultation with relevant sector leads.




## MSSMEB OVER TIME

Aug 2019 - March 2025 in SSP




## MSSMEB OVER TIME

Aug 2019 - March 2025 in USD




## MSSMEB OVER TIME<sup>6</sup>




## MSSMEB FOOD BASKET OVER TIME

Aug 2019 - March 2025 in SSP




## MSSMEB FOOD BASKET OVER TIME

The Minimum Expenditure Basket (MEB) is defined as an average cost of what a typical household requires to meet basic needs that could be covered entirely or partly through the market. The needs are defined as the critical goods and commodities, utilities and services required by households and recommended by the Sector Groups to ensure survival and minimum living standard.

Each sectoral MEB is covered up to a certain percentage: **Food (50% except priority<sup>8</sup> counties of Aweil East, Duk, Nyiroi, Pibor and Rubkona where it is 70%), WASH (20%), Shelter (20%), NFI (20%), Protection/GBV (50%), Health (50%), Energy (30%), Education (30%), Communication (100%), Milling Cost (50%) and Transport allowance (20%).** These are all calculated using the official USD-SSP rate. All calculated Sectoral MEBs are combined to create the full Survival Minimum Expenditure Basket (**SMEB**). The value for the Multipurpose Cash (**MPC**) is the calculated **SMEB** with an additional **30%** buffer for inflation.




## MEDIAN FOOD PRICES OVER TIME

August 2019 - March 2025 in SSP




## MEDIAN NFI PRICES OVER TIME

August 2019 - March 2025 in SSP




## MEDIAN CHICKEN PRICES OVER TIME




## MEDIAN GOAT PRICES OVER TIME




## USD EXCHANGE RATE OVER TIME









## Methodology

The JMMI aims to inform market-based programming in South Sudan. Coverage depends on the interest of the partner organisations and their field teams' capacities to regularly collect market data. Locations are added once partners willing to cover them are identified, and their field teams are trained. As the initiative is currently being built up, coverage will likely be expanded in future data collection rounds.

In each assessed location, at least four prices per food, non-food, and livestock items need to be collected from different traders to ensure the quality and consistency of the collected data (2 for currencies and milling costs). In line with the purpose of the JMMI, only the prices of the cheapest available types are recorded for each item.

Partner field teams identify traders to assess based on the following criteria:

- Traders are retailers selling directly to consumers.
- Traders with weight scales are prioritised when recording prices of dry food items.
- Traders need to be representative of the local price level.
- To the extent possible, the same traders are revisited in every data collection round.

The data is collected by field staff familiar with the local market conditions. They are trained on methodology and tools by REACH. Data collection is conducted through the ODK Collect mobile application. The data collection tool is published alongside the dataset every month and disseminated to the humanitarian community. Following data collection, REACH compiles and cleans all partner data, normalizing prices, cross-checking outliers, and calculating the median cost of an MSSMEB in each assessed location.

The median item prices reported in this factsheet are 'location medians', designed to minimise the effects of outliers and differing amounts of data among assessed locations. First, the median prices of all assessed items are calculated within each assessed location; then, REACH calculates the median of this list of medians. All MSSMEB and price index calculations are created using this method.

### MSSMEB Calculation

- The cost of the MSSMEB is calculated by multiplying the median price of each item in the respective location by the quantity listed in the table on page 3.

- Sorghum grain prices are used for the calculation of the cereal component, and maize grain prices for areas where maize is more commonly consumed. In areas where both cereals are consumed equally, the price of the cheaper item is used.
- Bean prices are used for the pulse component.
- Rather than the prices of vegetable oil, the prices of the cheapest locally available cooking oil is used.
- For airtime, a monthly cost of 1 USD is assumed, based on the rates of local telecom providers.
- All USD amounts are converted to SSP using the official rates of Central Bank of South Sudan.
- If a component of the MSSMEB is unavailable in a location, the overall median price is used for the calculation of the index.

### Challenges and Limitations

- Price data is only indicative for the time frame within which it was collected. Prices may vary between data collection rounds.
- The JMMI data collection tool requests the cheapest available type of each item to be recorded, as availability varies across regions. Therefore, price comparisons across regions may be based on slightly varying products.
- Standardising unit sizes of dry food items is inherently difficult in South Sudan, as many traders sell commodities by volume rather than weight. This may create a measurement error.
- With current coverage, data is mostly collected from main markets, which may not be representative of rural areas.
- As the JMMI continues to expand and is extended to additional locations, the reported changes in the overall median prices may be driven by shifts in coverage rather than actual price changes.

<sup>6</sup> The prices were normalised by setting August 2019 as the baseline and dividing each month's price by the price in August 2019.

<sup>7</sup> The Multipurpose Cash (MPC) is a cash transfer guide that has been designed to address multiple needs, with the transfer value calculated accordingly in the assessed locations.

<sup>8</sup>The SMEB and MPC calculate that 70% of the food basket is to be covered in the priority counties while 50% will be covered in other counties.
