

Top 3 Reported Drinking Water Availability Issues

- 1. Water networks damaged
- 2. Lack of water tanks
- 3. Lack of fuel for generators

Top 3 Reported Drinking Water Access Issues

- 1. Constraints to access networks
- 2 No chemicals for water treatment
- 3. Lack of resources to buy water

Most Urgently Required Water Interventions
