
Socio-Economic Vulnerability Map of Ukraine at the Sub-regional Area Level



Methodology note:

The data on age and income of population by area* level has been distributed in 1/3 percentiles, using the following thresholds: low – worst 33% of areas, medium – 33% to 66% of areas, high – top 66% to 99% of areas.

thresholds: low – worst 33% of areas, medium – 33% to 66% of areas, high – top 66% to 99% of areas.

The hybrid colors have been used to track the relationship between two variables. Each variable uses a distinct sequential color scheme to represent its classified data. Both schemes are combined into a grid-like legend showing all pattern combinations, allowing to view and explore how the variables may be related.
