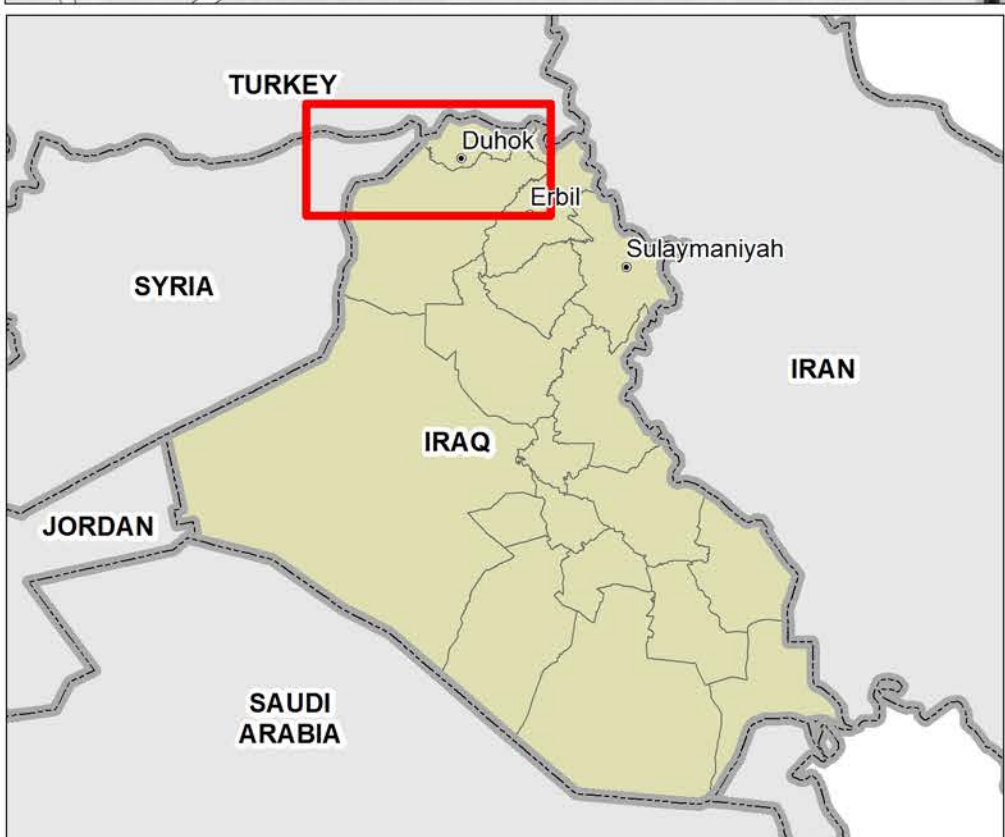
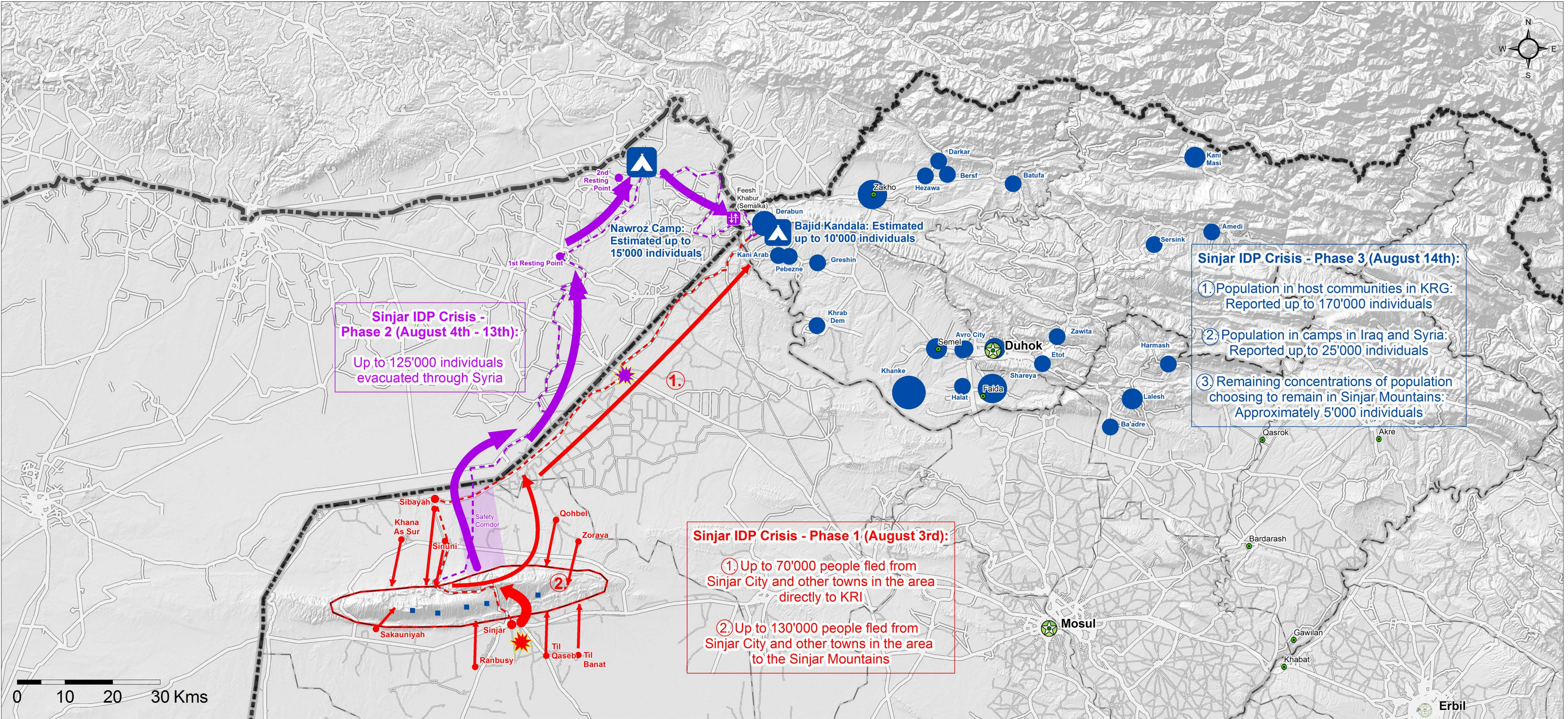


IRAQ - Sinjar IDP Crisis (3rd - 14th August)

Phases of Crisis

Phase 1: August 3rd

- Initial clashes on 3rd August
- Village of origin of IDPs
- IDP temporary safe haven
- Displacement trends
- Displacement route taken

Phase 2: August 4th - 13th

- Rabia border crossing point clashes (4th August)
- Opening of corridor for IDP movement to Syria (4th August)
- Displacement trends
- Displacement route taken
- Resting Point
- Border Crossing

Phase 3: August 14th

- Reported number of IDPs (Individuals) in host communities by key informants:
- < 1000
 - 1,001 - 5000
 - 5,000 - 15,000
 - 15,001 - 25,000
 - > 25,000
- Remaining Populations (precise locations unknown)
- Camps currently hosting Sinjar IDPs living in KRG (Bajid Kandala) and currently hosting Sinjar Refugees in Syria (Nawroz)
